✓	Development of a coordinated project plan (CPP) within 60 days of the project being posted to the Dashboard	
✓	Development of a comprehensive permitting timetable	✓
	 Transparency & Accountability	
✓	Project information such as applications, details of public meetings are posted to the Dashboard	✓
✓	Agencies must follow statutory procedures before changing permitting timetables	
✓	Agency failure to meet a posted completion date puts them in "nonconformance", is reported to Congress, and requires additional reporting	
✓	Quarterly reports detailing agency compliance are sent to Congress	✓
	 Qualify for Potential Funds	
✓	If determined necessary, with Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Director approval, the Executive Director may transfer funds to facilitate timely and efficient environmental reviews	✓
✓	 Active Engagement and Coordination Across Agencies	✓
